2nd Chance 4 Pets Director Appears On Bay Area CNN Headline News

LOS GATOS, CA (February 2006) -2^{nd} Chance 4 Pets Director Amy Shever was interviewed on Bay Area CNN Headline News. The interview will air on forty five-minute spots over the next several weeks. The non-profit organization is dedicated to eliminating the tragic euthanization of healthy pets due to the death or incapacity of their human companions,

The interview focused on the need for pet owners to make formal arrangements for their pets in the event they pass away or are no longer able to care for their pet. During the interview, Shever pointed out that a lack of awareness of lifetime care planning options results in more than 500,000 animals in the U.S. each year being relinquished to shelters and euthanized.

"It's a huge problem that is hardly recognized," stated Shever. "Pet owners assume they will outlive their pets, and don't realize the tragic consequences of not making plans in case something happens to them first. Our organization focuses on helping pet owners establish emergency plans and select caregivers who are committed to caring for their pets should the owner pass away or become too ill to care for them."
