2nd Chance 4 Pets Featured in the Latham Letter

LOS GATOS, CALIF. (July 2005)— Emergency planning information for pets was published in The Latham Foundation's Latham Letter publication. Gleaned from 2nd Chance 4 Pets, the information was featured in the winter 2005 issue. It offered an evacuation plan and emergency kit information and tips for both humans and animals.

As a non-profit organization, 2nd Chance 4 Pets is dedicated to eliminating the tragic euthanization of healthy pets due to the death or incapacity of their human companions. More than 500,000 pets are euthanized each year in veterinary offices or shelters.

In response to natural disasters like hurricanes Katrina and Rita, 2nd Chance 4 Pets offers emergency ID and contact cards to notify people there are pets in a home. The Latham Letter listed an emergency kit checklist --- including two weeks worth of food, medical supplies and dry bedding in the event of a disaster.
