2nd Chance 4 Pets Director Appears On National Public Radio's Motley Fool Show

LOS GATOS, CA (May 2005) -2^{nd} Chance 4 Pets Director Amy Shever was interviewed on National Public Radio's Motley Fool Show. The non-profit organization is dedicated to eliminating the tragic euthanization of healthy pets due to the death or incapacity of their human companions,

The interview focused on the need for pet owners to make formal arrangements for their pets in the event they pass away or are no longer able to care for their pet. Shever, who regularly speaks to veterinarians, animal welfare groups and pet owners, discussed the scope of the problem and the fact that pet owners aren't aware of lifetime care planning options.

"Each year, more than 500,000 animals in the U.S. are relinquished to shelters and euthanized because their owners passed away without making provisions for them," she pointed out. "We believe that through awareness and education programs, we can help pet owners make lifetime decisions for their pets, including establishing emergency plans, and selecting committed caregivers."
